It is now determined that the said average closing price is HK\$10.468. Accordingly, the number of new Shares which shareholders of the Company will receive in respect of their existing Shares for which cash election of the scrip entitlements to the said final dividend is not made will be calculated as follows:-

Fractional entitlements to the new Shares will not be allotted but will be refunded in cash to the respective shareholders concerned. The new Shares will not rank for the final dividend in respect of the year ended 30 June 2013 but will rank pari passu in all other respects with the existing Shares.

Application has been made to the Listing Committee of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited for the grant of listing of and permission to deal in the new Shares. It is expected that certificates for the new Shares and cheques for cash entitlements will be posted to shareholders of the Company at the risk of those entitled thereto on or before 31 December 2013.
